**Job Title:** Sports Leader

**Responsible to:** Sports Development Officer through the Sports Leader in Charge

**Hours of Work:** 25 hours per week

### Job Specification:

#### The main functions of the post are:

- To plan, lead and evaluate the GSLA Summer Sport & Leisure Programme.
- To produce safe and enjoyable session plans for all activities and events in the programme.
- To lead and support Volunteers in the delivery of sports sessions for children over the summer period.
- To administer First Aid as and when required.
- To undertake the induction for the Summer Sport and Leisure programme.
- To take part in evaluation sessions of the programme.
- To undertake any other appropriate duties which the Sports Development Officer or his/her representative may require.
